

## NATIONAL COLD BITUMEN

<b>DESCRIPTION</b>	Cold liquid Bitumen with added special materials, acts as a water insulator and vapor barrier for concrete and masonry by closing pores. Has good adhesion, good flexibility, and high resistance to rot.

### CONDITIONS DURING APPLICATION

Temperature of the substrate should be minimum 5°C

<b>STORAGE</b>	The product must be stored according to National Regulations. The product should be kept in a cool and well ventilated place, protected from heat and direct sunlight at temp 5-35°C. Containers must be kept tightly closed.
<b>HANDLING</b>	Handle with care, mix well before use.
<b>SHELF LIFE</b>	12 months.
